

Did you know?

- When it comes to septic systems, what goes in comes out? Almost all products eventually biodegrade, but do they biodegrade into something more harmful? Even in your septic system, you should assume that some of the extras in your soap, detergent or cleaner is going to leach into the lake, so be careful what goes in.
- NEVER bath in the lake using soaps or shampoos. They all contain ingredients you don't want to drink. YES. EVEN the ones that say they are safe for the water.
- Grey water pits are intended for cottages with minimal plumbing. Such as a kitchen sink, a single bathroom sink and a shower or tub. A typical design consists of a mini-field layout with up to 9 meters of distribution piping.
- Any additions to your plumbing will need approval from the Northwestern Health Unit.
- Your environmental committee has looked into four different issues on your behalf. Two are ongoing. One drainage issue has been addressed.
